UDOT and SLC Transportation agreed to include Foothill Dr crosswalks in the Adopt-A-Crosswalk program which includes pedestrian flags. Follow up: Ellen Reddick submitted contracts for four crosswalks on Nov 21. Sergeant Wolf said that SLCPD will work on an enforcement plan for Foothill Dr and adjacent streets. Residents expressed appreciation for the dramatic increase in traffic citations in District 6 in September and October. The residents in attendance voted in favor of considering a pedestrian overpass crossing of Foothill Drive.

The residents in attendance voted in favor of an eastside SLCPD precinct.

UDOT agreed to check the timing of the lights that allow east/west crossings of Foothill at 1300 S, 2300 E, and 1700 S.

SLC Transportation agreed to work on a plan for the school crossing light on 2300 East on the north and side sides of Cosgriff Memorial Catholic School (2335 Redondo Ave). Can the principal (Betsy Hunt) turn it on and off each day, or can it be on a timer?

UDOT explained that areas that are determined to be in “school zones” will be considered for improved signage, striping, lighting, etc. The crossings need to appear on each school’s Safe Walking Plan. Funding for infrastructure improvements are available for Foothill-adjacent streets and crossings from [UDOT Safe Sidewalks](#). Funding for improvements to city streets is available from [SLC Capital Improvement Program](#). Follow up: Aimee Burrows notified Melissa Ford at SLC School District and the Principals of Indian Hills, Beacon Heights Elementary, Clayton Middle, Hillside Middle, Cosgriff Memorial School about the need for a Safe Walking Plan and about the grant programs.

Residents in attendance voted to support a traffic calming program that SLC Transportation is going to request in the city budget. Dan Dugan noted resident support for the program.

Residents indicated that they want to U of U to prioritize decreasing traffic load along Foothill Dr for the university, medical campus, and Research Park.
