A. Overall in the city, there is a trend in 32% increase in violent crimes, year to date. Trying to figure out where it stems from. It is a nationwide trend. Our district had 0 calls of service for violent crime, we are down 29% in our district.

C. Several groups of kids coming onto Foothill Village property, typically on skateboards. Sometimes going into the properties with their PA systems. Security guards ask the kids to get out and the kids ignore them. Once officers arrive, kids take off. Det Meinzer once a day goes through the area to see if he can spot anyone. They are going to put up no trespassing signs. Hoping to catch the kids to be able to talk with their parents before issuing citations.
