I wanted to thank you so much for sending in your thoughts and concerns regarding the Lamplighter Square project on Foothill Blvd. I'm aware of the project to some degree, but as you probably know, I am not directly involved in planning and zoning issues. I had a meeting with the developer recently where they shared some background on numerous projects they are working on in the city, including this project, but the meeting was purely informational in nature.

While my administration facilitates the process, we do so according to policy and process established by the City Council. It would also be the City Council who makes final decisions regarding the project if the project is seeking permission outside of their legal building allowances already allowed by the zoning. I encourage you and the community to let these concerns be known to the council as they work through the necessarily applications associated with the projects. I understand the stresses the community feels regarding state roads, and state property – as it impacts the foothill communities a lot. This project would still need to adhere to Salt Lake City codes and current land use limitations. Any exceptions to that, if allowed, would need to be authorized through a public process via the Planning Commission and the City Council.

Thanks for taking the time to voice your concerns to me, I do appreciate it.
